

Samples #1 (last piece) from 62

The limestone here seems to never be broken in a
 manner of soil. Broken in there a clean cut exposure of undecomposed
 detrital limestone. But on the road cut, small amount of
 well developed - fine looking white granite and by
 all that hole, the pieces that made that granite
 have permeated this mixture of detrital material -
 a be Goodspeeds general hypothesis. Actual
 pebbles of be gravel + angular pieces of granite
 to be seen surrounded by granite - a soft disintegrating
 from granite to clay + back again imperceptibly. If
 this is a be Goodspeed, I'll eat my shirt + buy
 a size 44 special for the occasion.

Granite around 83 all dips back towards
 the rim above, but dips so at acute angles
 which vary from 20° to 65°, averaging probably 45°.
 This together with the fact that the mass is broken into
 huge pieces suggests it has slid from the recess in
 the rim above, & that the occurrence of granite at
 both this + lower elevation on this particular slope
 should not be construed to indicate be possible
 thickness of the deposit back under the rim of this
 main hill top - (area 77-79, etc)
