SQUAW BUTTES OBSIDIAN

Harney County

Obsidian float occurs along the Burns-Lakeview Highway at a point about 5 miles south of the junction with the Bend-Burns Highway. The obsidian probably originated on the flanks of Squaw Buttes some distance to the west. From the appearance of the float it seems likely that it was transported to its present location, possibly by Indians. Legal description is T. 24 S., R. 26 E.
